- Amrutha Shishunivasa has adopted one Govt. school situated at Mavalli, Bengaluru, where boys from rural areas are residing. They are provided with food, shelter and medical help.
- Girl children from villages near forest edge who have left school are given shelter at Hanur in the district of ChamaraJanagar. They are given Education and trained in various life skills and brought to the main stream.
- Amrutha Shishu Nivasa has taken initiative to construct a 120 beds hospital with an area of 70,000 sq.ft. at Poorna Pragna Layout, Uttarahalli, Bengaluru. The proposed hospital is a super speciality hospital for mothers and children from low socioeconomic section of society.

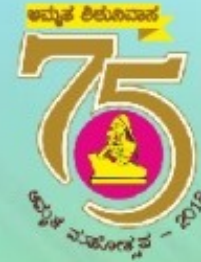

Amrutha Shishunivasa (Regd) (formerly known as Anatha Shishunivasa) was founded in 1942 by a group of philanthropists and public spirited men and women. It was functioning in a small rented house in Shankarapuram, an old residential area in Bengaluru. Later it was shifted in 1958 to a site granted by Government on Bull Temple Road, where the Nivasa premises is presently situated.

The idea of the founding fathers was for shelter and to support orphan and abandoned infants from day one onwards. The children referred by the Child Welfare Committee (CWC), Makkala Sahaya Vani (Child Help Line) in addition to the one abandoned at the road and left at the gate of the Nivasa are given shelter, support and solace.

The Shishu Nivasa has a sprawling compound with spacious building consisting of 4 halls (dormitory), a dining, a kitchen, a store, a study room & library, bath rooms and toilet blocks to ensure girls and boys stay separately.

### Education

Children are given Montessori education till they attain 5 years. Later they are sent to schools recognised by the State Government. After school hours, few volunteers from educational background will also guide the Shishu Nivasa children.

The children are helped to imbibe moral values. Activities aimed at character building are also planned by staff. The children are taken on trips to places of interest in and around Bengaluru.

Apart from the basic needs, the children are inculcated with good culture & education with the help of dedicated & service minded staff.



### Extra-Curricular Activities

The children are taught drawing, painting, patriotic songs, shlokas, dance, drama, music and moral stories. We have an excellent playground for outdoor games. The children are provided timely medical care by qualified doctors.

### Other Activities at Shishu Nivasa

- Nandana Shishu Mandira (Montessori education Centre)
- Computer Training (Vocational Training Centre)
- Tailoring Centre (for ladies)
- Sanjeevini Medical Centre (Free Medical Facility)

The Shishu Nivasa has enviable record of serving the orphan children for more than seven decades. It has decided to expand its activities multi-fold.

It is proposed to retain the children till they attain 18 years. Apart from formal education, the children are trained in job-oriented courses training centre established for the purpose. Children from weaker section of society, in addition to Shishu Nivasa children are trained in various trades to become self-reliant worthy citizens of society.

### Adoption

Our institution is recognised as an adoption agency by the State Government for in-country adoptions. This is a fit person's institution authorised by the Government.
